SUBJECTIVE SECTION

Caretaker says it was feeding time and Madison lunged at him so he grabbed her by the leash and held her away from his body. The other dogs in the adjacent crates were excited by this and one of them busted out of the crate and went after Madison's head. The caretaker pulled Madison away with her leash and kicked the loose dog, which ran upstairs. Another dog also busted out of its crate and also tried to go after Madison, which the caretaker said he didn't allow and also kicked and ran upstairs. The caretaker says he then ran upstairs because he remembered there was another dog upstairs and dragged/pulled Madison up the stairs with her leash behind him to get the other 2 dogs into their crate. Once he came back downstairs with Madison she collapsed and he brought her to Pet Vet.

OBJECTIVE SECTION

Oral: mm pink CRT<2 sec, minimal dental tartar, fractured 404 with pulp exposure, bruising and swelling underneath the tongue, blood tinged saliva/fluid oozing out of oral cavity
EENT: Anisocuria- OD larger than OS, pupils unresponsive to light, palpebral reflex present, periorbital swelling around OS, AU erythema, Thyroid WNL
CV/R: No M/A, Lungs clear bilat
Abd: SNP, No mass/organomegaly
NMS: Comatose, unresponsive to deep pain on extremities, cool extremities, BCS 5/9, spine WNL, hips WNL, stifles WNL
Integ: Puncture wound on the top of the rostral cranium, dorsal muzzle, right lateral muzzle, and above OD. Abrasion/excoriation on ventral neck 3x4inch likely from choke collar while being dragged.
PLN: wnl
U/G: Grossly wnl
Rectal: not done

Discussed severity of possible **brain damage** from event. Pupils being **unresponsive** to light, negative response to noxious stimuli, hypothermia, cardiac changes on ECG, a very guarded to **poor prognosis** is given. Discussed referral to VMCLI, but despite treatment, still may not respond to treatment. Can stay at Pet vet overnight per NH knowing there is no overnight care. Or humane euthanasia. Care taker elected humane **euthanasia** per rescue organization request.
